- The **Simulated Hospital** at MSU - Great Falls provides cutting-edge training to future healthcare professions. It is home to over 15 high-tech mannequins and state-of-the-art technical equipment.
- The college advances the region's largest economic sector by offering **18 health science programs** - more than any college in Montana.
