ELIGIBILITY

- Single parent (with at least one minor child living at home)
- Active as a community volunteer in one or more school, church, or youth groups
- Demonstrated financial need through a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the current academic year.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The Herb Waltermire Foundation presents scholarships to up to four full-time students, or up to eight part-time students, or some combination thereof, in every academic year, with reapplication required annually. Awards will be disbursed during fall and spring semesters. Scholarship funds will be shown as credits on your bill and funds are designated for payment of tuition, fees, books, or other academically relevant expenses.

APPLICATION PACKET REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Scholarship Application:** Complete the application form in its entirety.
- 2. Personal Statement:** Summarize why you chose your Major/Field of Study. Describe obstacles overcome, short-term goals, long-term goals, financial need, recent honors or awards, involvement in any community volunteer activities, and any other information you believe is relevant to the selection committee. (Please type and limit to one page).
- 3. One Letter of Recommendation:** Submit one letter from an instructor or from a personal reference, such as an employer, pastor, supervisor, etc. The letter must include the name, address, and telephone number of person making recommendation.
- 4. Current Unofficial Transcripts:** Continuing students who have completed at least one term do not need to submit transcripts. Transfer students must attach the most recent college transcript.
- 5. Completed FAFSA Application:** To be considered for ALL scholarships you must first complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for the 2010-2011 academic year by the deadline noted below. You can fulfill this requirement by applying online at www.fafsa.ed.gov or completing a paper form, available at the Financial Aid Office. Applicants must designate our school to receive this information; the school code is 009314.
