Admissions Checklist for International Students

Information required to complete Admission's file:

- _____ MSU Great Falls Application for Admission and \$30 application fee
- _____ TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) scores from an accredited testing service. A minimum score of 500 is the acceptable standard. More information about TOEFL may be obtained from the Education Testing Service, Princeton, NJ 08540. This is required only from students whose first language is not English.
- _____ Proof of completion of the equivalent of an American high school education with satisfactory grades. Transcripts need to be evaluated by a credential evaluation service to make this determination. Attached you will find a list of credential evaluation services.
- _____ A Declaration of Finances or other present evidence of funds necessary to pay all living expenses and travel to and from the College. (If being assisted with finances from another party, see our office for additional paperwork).
- _____ All nonimmigrant foreign students must show a physician-validated immunization record for measles, mumps and rubella. The evidence must be presented before a student will be permitted to register.
- _____ Evidence of an accident and sickness insurance policy or one of equal coverage for each semester in attendance at the College.
- _____ Copy of Passport, if available.
- _____ If sponsored, please submit a sponsor letter of support on your behalf.
- _____ Official transcript(s) from postsecondary institutions previously attended.
- _____ COMPASS, ACT, or SAT taken within the past 3 years for Writing and Math placement.

After a nonimmigrant foreign student has completed all the required items and returned the required forms, his/her admission file will be reviewed and a letter sent indicating either acceptance or denial of admission. Upon acceptance, MSU will issue an I-20 Certificate of Eligibility for non-immigrant "F-1" student status.
